Uniform

Mount Roskill Grammar has a clear set of guidelines for uniform (full details can be found at <http://www.mrgs.school.nz/enrolment/uniform.aspx>). These provide a consistency of expectation for all students and allow everyone to wear their uniform with pride. Hoodies, non-MRGS jackets, long sleeve T-shirts with short sleeve uniform shirts etc. are not part of the MRGS uniform.

As winter is now with us, if students need to purchase additional items, the uniform shop (gate 4 entrance) is open every Monday and Thursday from 8-9am and 3-4pm.

Frost Road / Early Childhood Pedestrian Entrance

Student safety is a priority in all schools, and one that we believe in very strongly at MRGS. To reduce vehicle and foot traffic, and thus risks for the children and their carers at the Early Childhood Centre, the entrance/exit gate on Frost Road (backfield access point) will be closed during the day. This means that students who live on that side of the campus will need to enter and exit via the Intermediate School entrance.

In the next few weeks, we will be launching an MRGS school app. The app will allow all our community quick and easy access to important dates and information. It will also improve the two-way communication between home and school. Among other things, the app will allow
